



Antique American Chestnut

The magnificent chestnut was once the dominant species in the Atlantic forest. Wiped out by blight in the early 20th century, this beautiful lumber is now available as carefully reclaimed timbers. With a rich golden color, our flooring includes all the character marks exhibited by recycled lumber.

No longer forested in America, chestnut is a rare wood whose rich golden-brown hues, variable grain, worm holes, random nail holes and dark gray oxidation marks combine to create the warmth so sought after today, just as it was centuries ago.

- **Color:** Variable from golden to chocolate brown with dark gray oxidation marks.
