



## Antique American Chestnut

The magnificent chestnut was once the dominant species in the Atlantic forest. Wiped out by blight in the early 20<sup>th</sup> century, this beautiful lumber is now available as carefully reclaimed timbers. With a rich golden color, our flooring includes all the character marks exhibited by recycled lumber.

No longer forested in America, chestnut is a rare wood whose rich golden-brown hues, variable grain, worm holes, random nail holes and dark gray oxidation marks combine to create the warmth so sought after today, just as it was centuries ago.

- **Knots:** Variable in size and frequency
- **Holes:** Random nail and worm holes
- **Grain:** Variable
- **Dimensions:**
  - **Thickness:** ¾-inch
  - **Random Lengths:** 1 ½ ‘ – 10’
  - Available Widths: 3” – 6”
- **Color:** Variable from golden to chocolate brown with dark gray oxidation marks.
- **Texture:** Smooth
